


Tonto Scout for Silver, Kemosabe!

No, Tonto is not searching for the fabled steed of his friend, the daring and resourceful masked rider of the plains. He is looking for SILVER MASTERPOINTS, which to some bridge players are nearly as precious. If you want to advance, you need SILVER points:

- * The rank of Sectional Master requires 5.
- * Regional Master requires 15.
- * NABC Master requires 25.
- * Advanced NABC Master requires 50.
- * Life Master requires 75.

The good news is that on Saturday, March 26, an event will be held at the Bridge Center in West Hartford, CT, the home of the Hartford Bridge Club. There will be two sessions of pairs games, one at 10, and the other at two. If two sessions seems excessive to you, you may just play in one of them.



In between will be **a free lunch**. We plan to split the group into two sections: One will be for players with under 200 masterpoints. Anyone who is not a Life Master and has less than 750 points can play in the other section.

These will be real bridge games, with actual playing cards, tables, and humans with faces and personalities. It should be exciting, interesting, and, most of all, fun.

All games at the tournament are **sectionally rated**, which means that players can earn considerably more masterpoints than in club games or regular online games. **.All the points will be silver**.
